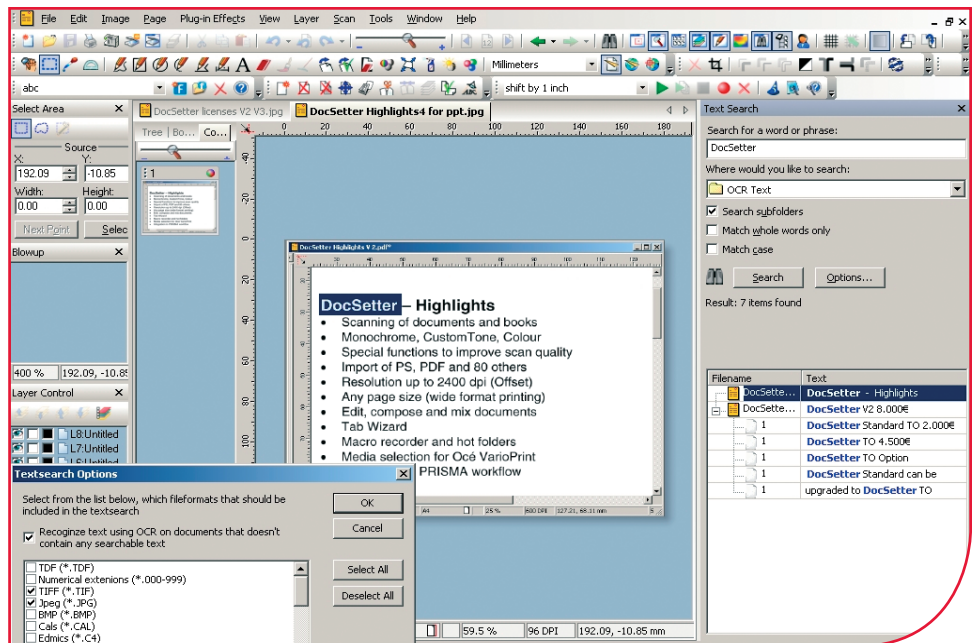

- Align pages precisely using guidelines for perfect printing
- Fully automate deskewing with maximum accuracy
- Use the intelligent despeckle filter to clean up your scanned files (erase marks, punch and staple holes) without adversely affecting image pixels
- Easily merge files to create new documents with a simple drag-and-drop operation using the QuickImport add-on
- Work with up to eight layers in documents and pages. Insert and merge color layers for colored fonts, logos, etc.
- Use DocWash to improve the scan quality of old or dirty originals
- Vectorize bitmaps
- Automatically optimize color and resolution for viewing and archiving

Streamline content makeready

- Add text, import images, select headers/ footers and pagination
- Rotate, stretch, scale, convert, separate and assemble pages from various sources
- Move objects with highly accurate, pixel-precise capabilities

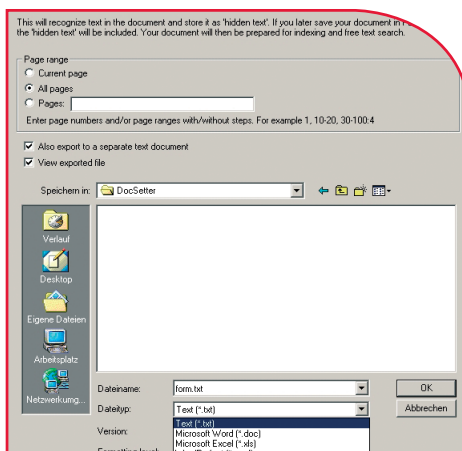

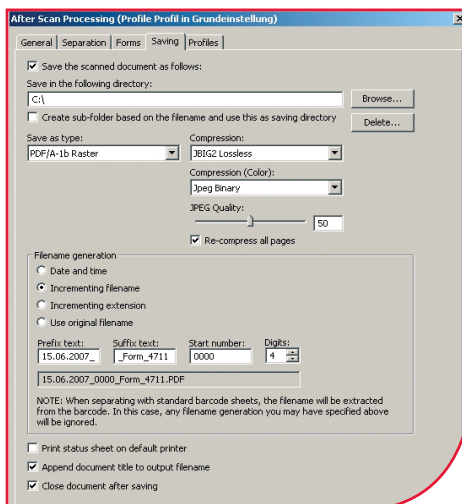
- Add value to scanned documents by enabling text searches, indexing and production of searchable PDF files in open documents using the OCR text recognition module

- Convert scanned documents into editable documents. Output formats include: text, Microsoft® Word®, Excel®, WordPerfect®, Rich Text Format, Open eBook®, HTML and XML
- Perform almost any document processing function and automatically save with proper file name generation after scanning based on barcode content
- Use previously recorded macros for advanced document processing in this fully automated document workflow
- Flexibly to use Océ DocSetter software with existing systems. Scan processing functions work with a variety of scanner configurations and types including direct control, Twain and network scanners. The archiving front end can be combined with the leading Océ PRISMAarchive archival solution.
