**Donation from Gordon Flesch Charitable Foundation  
Helps Kathy's House Feel like Home**

**MADISON, Wis. (November 23, 2008)** – The Gordon Flesch Charitable Foundation donated \$5,000 to Kathy's House in Milwaukee on October 23. The donation will help pay for an average eight-day stay at the nonprofit hospital hospitality house for eight families.

Founded in 2001 in memory of Kathy Kuettner, Kathy's House provides lodging and a supportive environment for patients and their families or caregivers who travel to Milwaukee hospitals for medical treatment. Guests are referred to the house by hospital staff and stay as long as hospital treatment requires. Kathy's House has eighteen individual suites as well as a communal kitchen, dining room and gathering room. Since its opening, Kathy's House has provided services to the families and caregivers of more than 1,500 patients.

“There is no charge to stay at Kathy's House, so we rely on generous donations like those from the Gordon Flesch Company,” said Richard Vogel, executive director for Kathy's House. “The donation helps us provide a ‘home away from home’ for our patients and their families.”

Remaining true to the company vision to “serve the communities where we work and live,” the Gordon Flesch Charitable Foundation, Inc. has donated more than \$800,000 to various charities and organizations in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Wisconsin since its inception in 2002. Each year, grants totaling \$100,000 are awarded throughout the communities where the Gordon Flesch Company does business.
