Gordon Flesch Charitable Foundation Donates \$15,000 to Indianapolis Area Charities

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. (August 10, 2011) – Donations totaling \$15,000 from the Gordon Flesch Charitable Foundation are helping three Indianapolis area organizations further their missions. - **Dayspring Center** - a full-service agency that provides emergency assistance and vital services to homeless families with children in central Indiana. The donation will provide art, science and math enrichment programs, as well as summer recreation programs.
